In addition to a 16' by 30' projection screen, stylish black drapes, a 26' by 40' sprung wooden stage floor, and nice gear for live sound production, the theatre also features a complete Dolby Digital 5.1 cinema sound system, and some very swinging, state-of-the-art acoustical wall panels.

Since the fall of 2004, when it officially opened its doors, the Al Whittle Theatre has hosted a large array of events including:

- workshops

In addition to the Al Whittle Theatre, the Community Room, a 22' by 40' multi-purpose room above the theatre lobby, is available for rental (by the day, by the week, or by the hour) for rehearsals, small performances or meetings.
